ALCOHOL AND DRUG SAFETY ACTION PROGRAM (ADSAP)

The South Carolina Alcohol and Drug Safety Action Program (ADSAP) is a statewide substance abuse program for individuals who are convicted of driving under the influence (DUI), individuals who are referred by the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources for boating under the influence (BUI) and individuals whose licenses are suspended through the state's Administrative License Revocation (ALR) procedure.

Each person will be assessed to determine their needs to reduce the risk for future substance misuse problems. Upon completion of the assessment, the counselor will decide the focus of service and the level of care that will best meet the individual's needs.

For your initial appointment, be prepared to bring:

- Picture Identification
- A current copy of your 10 year driving record
- A minimum payment of \$250.00

The ADSAP cost is based on the level of care completed-\$500.00 for education/intervention services and up to \$2,000.00 for treatment services.

If the arrest is over 10 years old, you will need to bring the suspension letter from the DMV that shows the DUI arrest and conviction dates.
